## 57 Josh Herrin

### Career history

Born in Glendale, Calif., Herrin won the 2004 USGPRU title at age 14 and the 2005 WERA 600 National Championship before turning Pro in 2006. In 2010, he won the historic Daytona 200 at 19 years old, becoming the youngest rider since 1955 to win the event. Herrin is the 2013 AMA Superbike Champion and 2016 MotoAmerica SuperStock 1000 Champion. He competed in Moto2 in 2014.

Herrin coaches riders at Herrin Compound, his family's supermoto track in Dublin, Ga. 15-year-old Gavin Anderson, one of his riders, is competing in MotoAmerica Liqui Moly Junior Cup on the No. 76 Attack Performance/Herrin Compound Graves Yamaha YZF-R3.

Herrin's first foray onto the World Superbike grid has him pulling double duty on the No. 57 Attack Performance/2 Wheel Legal Yamaha. Herrin and team will also compete in MotoAmerica Motul Superbike using the same machine, only changing tires to the Pirelli spec tire and number plates (Herrin rides the No. 2 MotoAmerica Motul Superbike). Bike owner Richard Stanboli has past success in similar appearances having scored points with rider Steve Rapp in MotoGP competition in 2012 with a bike he created out of billet aluminum.
